We are very sorry that you the members, having supported the Association for many years, perhaps even from the beginning, are suddenly losing a link with numerous cousins that you may have met and with whom you may have fraternized during our Family Reunions.

We will cherish the memory of those precious times and assure you that it would be a great pleasure to meet you once again should you travel our way.
